

Biography – Victor H. Reis

Dr. Victor H. Reis is Senior Advisor, Office of the Secretary, Department of Energy. He is also a member of the Strategic Advisory Group of the U.S. Strategic Command.

Dr. Reis led the development of the DOE's Stockpile Stewardship Program when he was Assistant Secretary for Defense Programs in the U.S. Department of Energy.

His past government appointments include serving as Director of the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA), Director of Defense Research and Engineering (DDR&E) at the Pentagon and Assistant Director for National Security and Space, Office of Science and Technology Policy, Executive Office of the President, (OSTP).

He has been a Senior Vice President at SAIC, and a Senior Staff Member at MIT Lincoln Laboratory and other industrial positions. He has chaired and served on numerous government and laboratory committees.

Dr. Reis earned a B.M.E. in Mechanical Engineering from the Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, (1957) an M.Eng. in Mechanical Engineering from Yale University (1958); and an M.A. and Ph.D.(1962) from Princeton University. He has authored numerous scientific and policy publications and his awards include two Department of Defense Distinguished Public Service Medals.
